Dear Parents/Carers,

Applications are now open for children in year 6 to apply for a high school place. It is really important that when applying for high school that you put down 6 schools in the order of your choice. Last year some parents only chose one or two schools and their children were given places in High Schools in Reddish or Bredbury. This caused a high degree of anxiety for the children and families and many had to attend appeals to get a school close enough to home. We have a vacancy on our Governing Body and would like to invite parents to join us. Please don't be put off by the process, we are really friendly and welcome applications from parents of children in all age groups. Any questions, please pop into school and ask or catch one of us at the door in the morning. All families received a letter on Friday with the following information:

### **PARENT GOVERNOR ELECTION**

I am writing to you to invite you to stand for election as a parent governor, or nominate another parent to do so. In our school we have provision for 2 parent governors and there is currently 1 vacancy.

The governing board, with the Co-Headteachers, has overall responsibility for the running of the school. Governing boards have three core strategic functions:

- Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction;
- Holding the headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils; and
- Overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent.

No special qualifications are needed and the most important thing is to have a keen interest in the school and be prepared to play an active part in the work of the governing board. However, we would particularly welcome nominations from parents with the following skills: Health and Safety; teaching and learning; safeguarding, a love of school, wanting to make a difference. Training is available for all governors and this governing board has an expectation that those new to governance attend free induction training.

The enclosed sheet summarises the circumstances under which someone cannot serve as a governor. In addition, parents/carers who have paid employment in the school for 500 or more hours per academic year or who are elected members of the Local Authority are not eligible to stand in these elections. Nominations must be from parents or carers with children at the school on the day that nominations close. All new governors are required to have a DBS check which is required to have commenced within 21 days of appointment.

If you would like to stand for election please complete the enclosed nomination form and return it to the school no later than 18<sup>th</sup> October at 12:00pm. You may also include a short personal statement to support your nomination, which should be no longer than 250 words. Self-nominations will be accepted, but if you are nominating another parent please seek their prior consent.

Please be aware that, in the event of a ballot being held, your personal statement will be shared with all the parents in school. Please do not include any personal information for that reason.

If there are more nominations than vacancies the election will be by secret ballot. If that is necessary, voting papers will be sent to all parents together with details of the ballot procedure.

#### **ELECTION CALENDAR**

- 6 Oct Nomination forms to be given to children in school and posted to the parents of children who are absent. The election can also be shared electronically but there should not be a hybrid process.
- <u>18 Oct</u> Closing date- 12:00 midday. *Please draw the disqualification clauses and code of conduct shown in the attached form to the nominees' attention.*

Headteachers should check the validity of nominations received. If the election is uncontested, please send me the details of the successful candidate/s; who will be **elected** parent governor/s.

In the case of a contested election ballot papers should prepared and sequentially numbered.

- <u>30 Oct</u> Ballot papers and reply envelopes issued to those eligible to vote if using a paper process:
  - i) for children in school to take home and
  - ii) posted (first class) to parents of absent children.

8 Nov Close of poll - 12.00 mid-day. The Returning Officer will arrange for the checking and

counting of votes. Candidates may be invited to attend the counting of votes.

# 8 Nov **DECLARATION OF RESULTS**

- i) Parents notified by letter or newsletter of the names of parent governors elected.
- ii) Written notice of the results sent to me; I will then send the new governor welcome pack to the successful candidate/s.

### **School Uniform**

If you do not wish to use a school PE kit please let your class teacher know and provide a PE kit for your child.

Year 5 will have swimming on Monday each week, all other classes from year 1 to 6 will have two lessons each week where PE kits are used.
